that we may live the joy of the Gospel.*

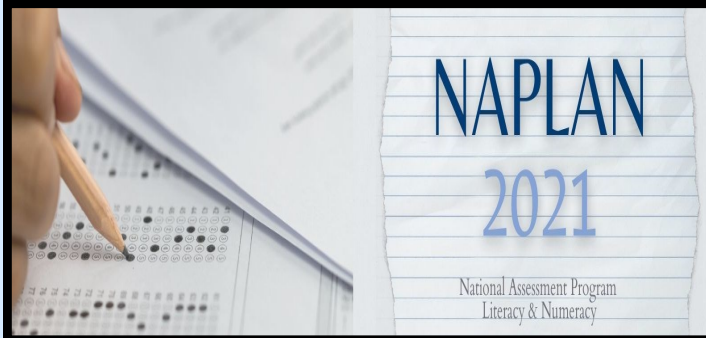

Tickets will be available to purchase from Monday 25<sup>th</sup> October (week 2) through the QKR! App. There will only be one performance.

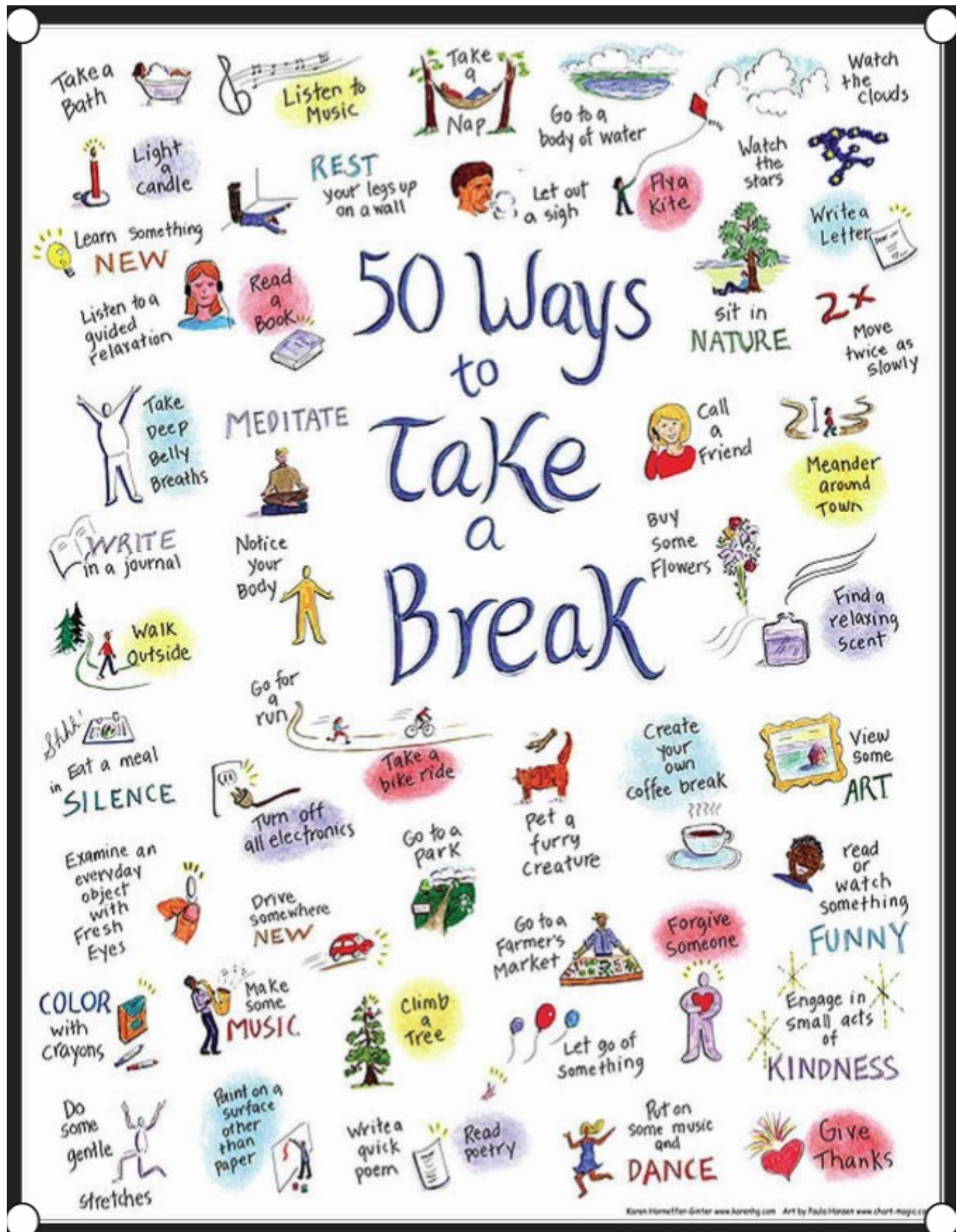
